# Major Milestones – Featured Projects

# Glenn McConnell Parkway Widening

- Contractor is approaching completion of additional travel lane and intersection improvements on eastbound side roadway
- Contractor working on shared-use path adjacent to eastbound travel lanes
- Project lighting installation in early 2024
- Construction substantially complete end of 1st Quarter 2024

# Maybank Highway Improvements – Northern Pitchfork

- Contractor working to complete Phase 2 from Stono Oaks Apartments to River Road
- Maybank Restriping TBD after change order executed
- Project substantially completed in January 2024, with final completion end of 1st Quarter 2024







# Palmetto Commerce Interchange

- Project will reduce congestion, improve access, and increase mobility in the I-26/Ashley Phosphate Road area
- Construction began August 1, 2023, with substantial completion expected in February 2026
- Community Meeting scheduled for Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> @ 6 pm

Segment A - US 17 and Main Road Intersection & Main Road **Improvements – Bees Ferry to River Road** 

- Currently securing right-of-way along the project corridor
- 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2024 Army Corps of Engineers environmental • permit review & decision
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024 Award design-build contract**
- 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2024 Begin construction
- 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2028 Project substantially complete

**Segment C** - Bohicket Road Improvements – Maybank Highway to **Betsy Kerrison Parkway** 

January 18, 2024 – Public Meeting

2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2024 – Develop Preliminary 30% Plans

**3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024 – Prepare and Submit USACE Permit** 

2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2025 – Begin Right-of-Way Acquisition process

# Current Transportation Sales Tax Programs

- 1<sup>st</sup> Transportation Sales Tax
  - ½-cent sales tax
  - Began collections in FY2005
  - \$1.3 billion by the end of FY2026
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Transportation Sales Tax
  - Additional ½-cent sales tax
  - Collections in FY2017 FY2042
  - \$2.1 billion



# **3<sup>rd</sup> Transportation Sales Tax** Background

- February 1, 2023 Council directed staff to research financial approach to fund Mark Clark Extension project Staff determined continuation of Transportation Sales Tax
  - program was best approach
- May 18, 2023 Chairman Sass requested staff formulate plan for **2024 Transportation Sales Tax referendum.**





## Proposed 3<sup>rd</sup> Transportation Sales Tax

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Transportation Sales Tax would replace 1<sup>st</sup> Transportation Sales Tax
  - Continue ½-cent sales tax
  - 25-year collection period
  - FY2027 FY2052
  - \$5.4 billion
  - Provides funding for:
    - Transportation Infrastructure Improvements
    - Mass Transit
    - Greenbelt Program
